

Rules and Regulations

Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current MHSA, CESHs and CBHSA Rule Books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Exhibitors shall be held responsible for the entry fees of all the horses entered by them or their agents. Horses must be scratched prior to the start of a class in order for the entry fee to be refunded.

The Committee reserves the right to decline any entry and to return the entry fee before or during the show without being liable for compensation.

Care should be taken to enter each horse correctly. Age of horses, along with their description must be stated. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors, and those of their agents. Please include all necessary card numbers.

Courses will consist of 8 to 12 fences at the required height for the section and may include brush, walls, in and outs, post and rails, natural oxers, alkens, coups and gates.

Three entries are necessary to fill a performance class unless otherwise specified or class may be declared void at the discretion of the Committee.

The Committee reserves the right to change the order of classes and to cancel classes in case of darkness or inclement weather or in the interest of time.

Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and all entry fees shall be forfeited.

Schooling fences are provided.

The management is not liable for any injury to person or horse at any time, which includes going to, coming from, and in the ring. Neither will it be responsible for any vehicles, or any articles that may be lost or damaged. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be submitted to the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

Proof of negative Coggins must accompany entries or be shown to the Show Secretary when picking up numbers.

To be eligible for a Hunter Under Saddle Class in any rated hunter section, horses must be entered in at least one full point class over fences in the same section. To maintain awards or points won in these classes, the entry must complete the course in at least one class. EXCEPTION: Delmarva Classes.

Champions and Reserve Champions will be awarded to all hunter divisions of two of the four ponies or horses which have acquired the most points in classes over fences. In addition, only those four horses or ponies will receive points won in under saddle classes. EXCEPTION: Delmarva Classes.

All riders must be suitably attired and must wear USA Equestrian approved head gear at all times when mounted.

No person will be allowed in the Show Rings during the time of judging except those having duties to perform.

Foxden Farm, the owners of the grounds, MHSA, CESHs or CBHSA will not be responsible for any injury or injuries to any person, horse, or property incurred.

Anyone creating a disturbance will be removed from the grounds.

Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Steward, whose decision shall be final.

Riders in pony or junior classes not to have reached their eighteenth (18) birthday prior to December 1, 2007.

Directions:

From Chestertown: Take MD 291 to Rt. 6 in Delaware. Turn right on 42. Go thru Kenton and continue 3 miles on 42 to Kenton Rd. (104). Turn right onto 104 and go 2.5 miles to Denneys Road. Turn right onto Denneys Road. Foxden Farm is .6 miles from 42 on the left.

From Route 13 S: Go North thru Dover to Delaware Technical & Community College at Denneys Road. Turn left onto Denneys Road. Foxden Farm is 2.9 miles from Route 13 on the left.

From Route 13 N: Go South to Delaware Technical & Community College at Denneys Road. Turn right onto Denneys Road. Foxden Farm is 2.9 miles from Route 13 on the left.

From 301 North: Take 300 to 44. Go thru Hartly to Route 8. Take Route 8 to Pearsons Corner. At Pearsons Corner, turn left. Take the next right (Denneys Road) and go 3 miles. Foxden Farm is on the right.

From 301 South: Take 302 to Templeville. Turn right onto 454 to Marydel. 454 becomes Route 8. Take Route 8 to Pearsons Corner. At Pearsons Corner, turn left. Take the next right (Denneys Road) and go 3 miles. Foxden Farm is on the right.
